Calls for Service

Training

Use of force training will be in March and April with Saugeen Shores Police Service.

Police Cruiser

With the approval of Council for us to use pre budget approval for the purchase of a new cruiser, I am going to recommend that we return to our original plan of purchasing a Ford Explorer and replace the Chrysler. The 2004 Ford Taurus has some surface rust but has not had any major mechanical issues since its purchase. I feel that we can continue to use this vehicle as an administration vehicle.
