

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WINGHAM

BY-LAW NO.1488

A by-law to permit public games and sports in the afternoon of the Lord's Day.

WHEREAS it is deemed advisable by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wingham to pass a by-law permitting Sunday Sports.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wingham enacts as follows:

1. Section 1 of the Lord's Day (Ontario) Act 1960 -61 is hereby declared to be in force in the Town of Wingham.
2. The application of the said Section of the said act shall apply to the whole of the Town of Wingham .
3. The application of the said Section of the said Act shall be limited to the respective public games or sports in the Town of Wingham as follows:

Baseball, Softball, Lacrosse, Soccer, Rugby, Bowling, Hockey, Swimming, Water Sports, Tennis, Basketball Badminton, skating and curling.

4. The public games and sports named in this by-law shall be subject to the following regulations and controls;
 - (a) Every such game or sport shall be conducted in an orderly and seemly manner.
 - (b) No such game or sport shall be commenced before half-past one o' clock in the afternoon of the Lord's Day.
