RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the Council of the Township of North Huron hereby approve the \$5,700 expense to purchase flowers for Wingham and Blyth hanging baskets and planters as part of the Parks' budgets, in advance of the 2018 budget approval.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The flowers for the hanging baskets and planters are ordered in November to be ready for Spring 2018. Staff are requesting pre-budget approval for this item.

DISCUSSION

In both Wingham and Blyth downtowns, the Township purchases flowers for the hanging baskets and planters. This is a program to support downtown beautification. The Township needs to order the plants in November so that they can be ready for spring 2018.
