RECOMMENDATION:

THAT the Council of the Township of North Huron hereby appoint a Member of Council - _____, to sit on the Court of Revision for the Walsh Municipal Drain.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Council of the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry in accordance with Section 78 of the Drainage Act requested R. J. Burnside & Associates to prepare an Engineer's Report for the Walsh Municipal Drain 2016. The objective of the report is to establish the watershed area contributing to the Walsh Municipal Drain and to determine a solution to alleviate the ponding and surface erosion currently taking place within the area. The Report recommends abandoning the existing Municipal Drain and constructing a new Walsh Municipal Drain from its' outlet into the extension of the existing Grasby Municipal Drain in Lot 4, Concession 7, Municipality of Morris-Turnberry (Morris Ward), County of Huron to the lot line between Lots 41 and 42, Concession 6, Township of North Huron (former geographic Township of East Wawanosh), County of Huron.

The Drainage Act states, in part, "where more than one municipality is involved the Court consists of two members from the initiating municipality and one member from each of the other affected municipalities.

The Council of the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry at their May 17, 2016 Council Meeting passed Motion 254-2016 "That the Members for the Court of Revision for the Walsh Municipal Drain be: 3 members, Paul Gowing and Jamie Heffer from the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry and one member from the Township of North Huron".

A Court of Revision for the Engineer's Report for the Walsh Municipal Drain - 2016 has been scheduled for Tuesday, June 7, 2016 at 8:30 pm, at the Municipality of Morris-Turnberry Council Chambers.
