Statement from the Huron Perth Landowners Association

The Huron Perth Landowner's Association states that it fully supports a recent statement made by North Huron Reeve Neil Vincent at a North Huron council meeting. The HPLA would like to point out that municipal councils have voluntarily given away much of their authority to urban centres, and that it is up to councils to bring that decision-making process back home to the people."
