Does North Huron currently have equipment capable of clearing the west pedestrian path on Hanna Bridge in the winter time?

How many human-hours (per year or season) are currently spent clearing sidewalks in Wingham?

How much is it currently costing taxpayers to clear sidewalks during the winter months in Wingham?

During the snow months there always "down days" when there has been no precipitation or need for winter maintenance equipment to be deployed. These periods can last for days to weeks. What are the town staff that normally run the sidewalk clearing equipment and snow plows doing during these "down days"? Are they "on the clock" or just not called in?

Reason for information request:

I know that previous Public Works Department Heads (up to Kelly Church) have never been asked by council for costing on clearing sidewalks. I would like access to this information to further the debate on pedestrian safety.
