

BOARD REPORT SEPTEMBER 2018

CALLS FOR SERVICE

During the months of June to August 2018 Wingham Police responded to 420 calls for service. During the same period in 2017, we had 412 calls. Attached is the crime statistics summary for May.

OACP

The Zone 5 meeting is being held on 18 September in Waterloo.

TRAINING

Firearms training is ongoing and our officers are being transitioned to the new sidearm purchased in the spring.

I will be attending the use of force training in Saugeen Shores 17/18 October. Should the disbandment be delayed by the OCPC, all of our officers will have to undergo training in April next year.

I will be attending the small to mid sized Chiefs' conference Oct 2-4 in Gananoque.

RECRUITING

Recruiting has been put on hold until the confirmation of disbandment is received from the OCPC.

SIU

As a result of being called to back up the OPP in Whitechurch, two of our officers have been designated as "Witness Officers." The SIU will conduct their investigation and report their findings to the OPP.

BUILDING REPAIR

The roof is being repaired.

RECEPTIONIST RETIREMENT

Our receptionist/records clerk has retired. We have been working through some difficulties without her. It is extremely difficult to find anyone with the specific qualifications required who is willing to fill in as a temporary. Owen Sound Police have been assisting us with CPIC entries and the officers have been completing their crown briefs.
