Budget Changes/Highlights

- From Version #1 12.83% reduced to 3.91%
- 1% Levy increase = \$45,302.73
- Howson Dam Environmental Assessment included at \$80,000 offset by transfer from Howson Dam Reserve
- Donations for large requests removed only \$25,000 included

- Memorial Hall Township contribution for 2016 in the amount of \$116,667 reduced to \$50,000 making Township total in reserves \$200,000. We will have to borrow the remainder of \$300,000 to meet the Township contribution of \$500,000
- Memorial Hall Phase 1 Renovation Project costs included at \$1,542,000 offset by the contribution from 14/19 of \$1,307,000 and NH transfer from reserve of \$235,000 (short by \$35,000)
- Blyth Well Upgrades Tender Award costs included in the budget note that the building costs were not included in the grant
- MVCA Budget original estimate reduced by \$2,677
- Physician Recruitment original estimate reduced by \$2,859
- Wescast Pool transfer to Reserve reduced to \$45,000 2016 therefore includes a transfer to
 reserve in the amount of \$45,000 plus actual investigation work of \$20,000 It will be most
 likely that funds will have to be borrowed for this project given the total cost research will be
 conducted to see if this project will be eligible under any of the new grant programs
- Wescast Complex Roof Renovations \$82,000 offset by transfer from reserves
- Townhall Renovations \$20,000 removed
- Patrick Street included Motion Required for OCIF Formula Based Funding Grant due March 31
- Required a reduction for PW transfer to reserve from \$75,000 to \$54,500 = \$20,500 to proceed
