The Director of Recreation and Facilities provides a monthly report of department activities and ongoing projects to keep Council informed.

DISCUSSION

Blyth Memorial Community Hall Renovation Project

The project is scheduled to achieve Substantial Completion on March 31, 2017. A media tour was hosted on February 22, 2017 to tour media outlets through the renovation progress. The Blyth Memorial Community Hall Renovation Committee met on February 22, as did the Blyth Memorial Community Hall Information Kiosk Committee. The renovation committee will be holding their next meeting on March 22 which will include a walkthrough of the renovation. The Kiosk committee is working on the content for the interactive touch screen kiosk for the lobby.

Family Day

Family-Fun-Apalooza-Winter-Luge-Athon was held in North Huron on February 19 & 20. The following are the event statistics:

Huron County HKCC (Healthy Kids Community Challenge)
